## Contest Purpose

In honor of Domestic Violence Awareness Month (October 2012) and Sexual Assault and Child Abuse Awareness Month (April 2013), we are inviting all Alaskan youth to engage in creating a positive message about respect and healthy relationships.

## Who Can Participate

All Alaskan school children from preschool through high school are eligible to participate. Home schools, alternative and traditional schools are all welcome.

## Poster Guidelines

Artist should depict this year's theme, "iRespect" with appropriate imagery and wording. Teachers are asked to select a finalist from each classroom to submit to the Governor's office. Posters should follow these guidelines:

- No larger than 9"x12" or smaller than 8.5"x11"
- Bold colors and simple fonts are best
- Electronically or manually designed
- Name of the artist, school, and grade as well as the teacher's contact information should be included on the back of the poster.
- **Posters must be received electronically or via mail by December 10, 2012.**
