- 4. Art media: Use one or more of the following materials: crayons, pencils, watercolor, paints, markers, ink, pastels, chalk, cut paper or photography.
- 5. Artwork must be ORIGINAL! (no traced, trademarked or copyrighted characters and slogans, such as Snoopy, Spongebob, Disney, Dora the Explorer, etc.). No copying.
- 6. Each poster must have a submission form filled out. Submitted artwork becomes the property of the GCDSE.
