

ALASKA MIGRANT EDUCATION PROGRAM

CHILD ELIGIBILITY

A child *may* qualify for the program if:
Out of **economic necessity**, the family **traveled** to engage in **fishing** (commercial, subsistence, or processing), subsistence **berry picking**, commercial **logging**, or **agricultural** work for at least a total of **7 nights / 8 days**.

Note: There are many ways a child may qualify for the Migrant Education Program. Contact your school district if anyone in your family engages in these types of activities!

HOW TO ENROLL

Contact your school district!

A trained recruiter will interview you to determine if your children could be eligible for the program.

PROGRAM SERVICES

Services vary by school district.

The program provides **instructional** and **support services** that help migratory children succeed in school and graduate high school prepared for **responsible citizenship**, **further learning**, and **productive employment**.
