## • K-12 Foundation Program and Pupil Transportation

- Foundation program fully funded with a Base Student Allocation of \$5,930; Estimated total: \$1,162,308.5 UGF and \$31,166.7 Public School Fund
- o Pupil Transportation fully funded based on statutory formula; Estimated total: \$71,435.8 UGF
- Additional Foundation
  - Donations from Dividend Raffle for distribution to school districts; Estimated total: \$550.0 O Statutory Designated Program Receipts (SDPR)
- K-12 Support
  - o Eliminate unused funding in the Residential School Program; Total: (\$45.6) UGF
  - o Increment for the Special Education Service Agency (SESA) based on statutory formula; Total: \$1.1 UGF
