♦ ISSUE

In October 2024, the State Board of Education passed a resolution directing the Department of Education and Early Development (DEED) to develop model district guidance and policy to support implementation of Artificial Intelligence (AI) practices in schools. As AI is a fast developing field with wide ranging implications for education, districts require support in best practice as well as tools and resources to guide district usage.

♦ BACKGROUND

- In October 2024 the SBOE passed a resolution directing DEED to develop resources and tools to support districts with AI policy and implementation guidelines.
- In May 2025 Anthony White was hired to serve as the DEED Computer Science Content Specialist.
- In June 2025 Anthony convened a workgroup to support DEED in developing an AI Framework.
- In August 2025 the workgroup presented a draft AI Framework for review and preparation for presentation to the SBOE.
- Kelly Manning, Deputy Director of IEE, and Anthony White, DEED Computer Science Content Specialist, will provide a presentation on the AI Framework and policy guidance.
