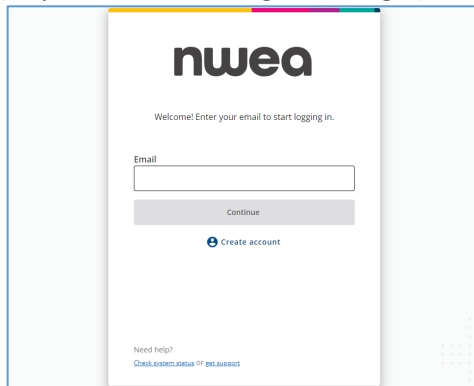


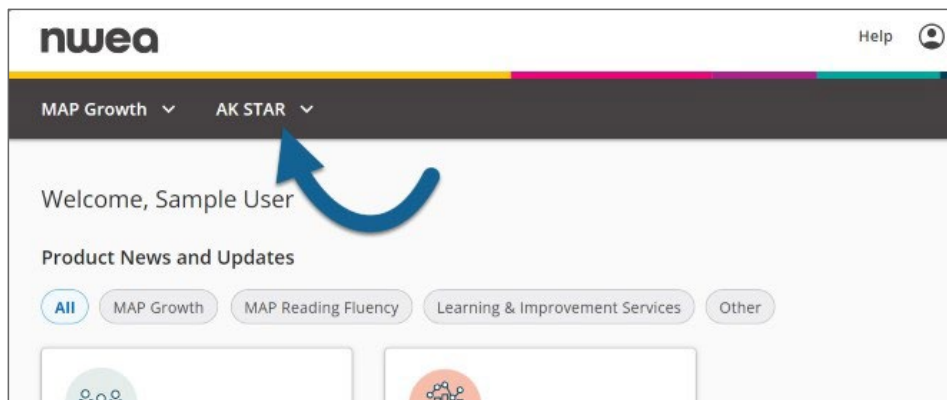
Quick Guide: Accessing Performance Results in the AK STAR Administration Portal

District Test Coordinators, as well as district and school leaders and instructors with report permissions, can access spring assessment results in the AK STAR Administration Portal. The following step-by-step process can be used to access different levels of reports based on established permissions.

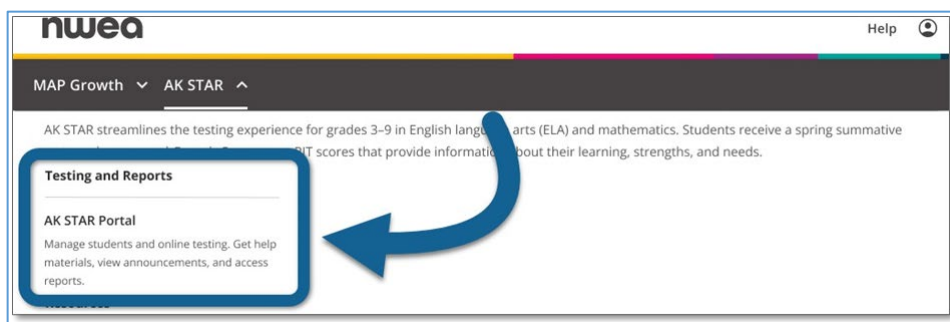
1. NWEA has a central login for both MAP Growth and AK STAR Administration Portal where the Online Reporting System (ORS) provides spring AK STAR results using the same login. Go to [NWEA](https://auth.nwea.org/adult/login) (<https://auth.nwea.org/adult/login>) and sign in using your username and password.



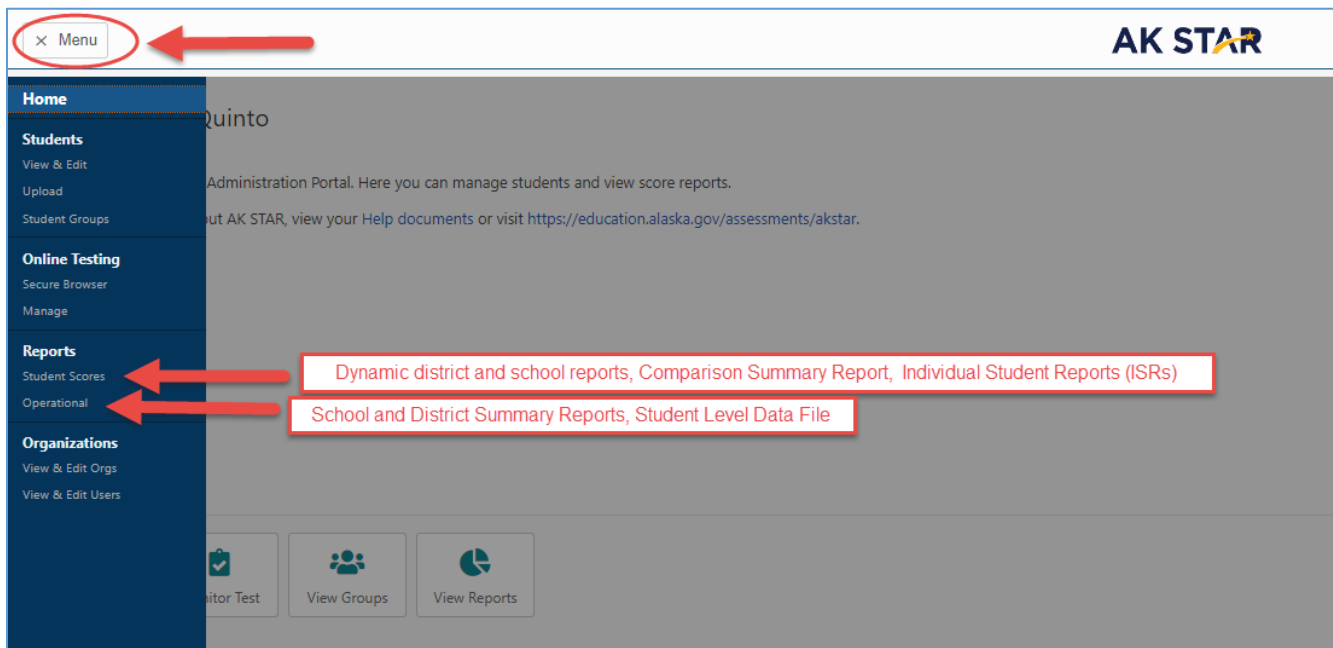
2. Select **AK STAR**.



3. Select **AK STAR Portal**.



4. Select **Menu** followed by **Student Scores** or **Operational**, depending on what report(s) you want to access.
