Individual Student Report (ISR)	For students, parents, and educators	Alaska Science Assessment ISR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provides individual student's scale score, achievement level, comparison to other students, and scores for related sub-categories <u>Contains confidential student information</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Useful for understanding how a student performed overall on the standards at a grade level at the end of the school year Compare a student's performance to other students in the school, district, or state Based on the ELA, Mathematics, or Science sub-categories and student performance in each category, and other classroom- or district-level information available for individual students, educators can use the information about general strengths and weaknesses of individual students for areas that may need instructional support in the next school year
		AK STAR ISR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provides individual student's summative scale score and achievement level Provides growth component overall RIT scores, growth, percentiles, and instructional area RIT scores <u>Contains confidential student information</u>	
School Summary Report	For school leaders, educators and the public	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provides summary information for whole school, district, and state Includes number of students tested, percentage in each achievement level, median and mean scale scores, and relative performance on sub-categories 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Useful for information about the performance of the educational system at a school level Determine grade level or content areas where program or instruction may be improved to increase student achievement
District Summary Report	For educators and the public	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provides summary information for whole district and state Includes all information provided in school summary reports at the district level 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Useful for information about the performance of the educational system at a district level Determine grade level or content areas where program or instruction may be improved to increase student achievement

Comparison Summary Report (AK STAR Only)	For use by district level users only	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provides summary comparison of scale scores Customizable multi-school, grade, and content area views Provides aggregated data based on selection criteria 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Useful to districts to compare assessment results across schools, grades, or content area Can be used to develop district level data for presentations
Student Score Data File	For use by district level users only	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Contains all reportable student data within a particular district, including demographic and student score data, sorted by Reporting School Code, and Alaska Student State ID <u>Contains confidential student information</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Useful to district data analysts to view, download, and analyze data Useful to download data into district Student Information System (SIS) Can be used to develop district reports and presentations
Student Roster Report (Alaska Science Only)	For use by district	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provides the following information for each student in a grade level at a school: scale score, achievement level, performance on reporting categories <u>Contains confidential student information</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Useful for seeing individual student information for a subject See trends in the performance of reporting categories May be useful for educators to consider instructional modifications at a grade level in the next school year
Organization Report – School and District (AK STAR only)	For use by district users and school administrators	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provides a histogram and list view of district to school to student results data and performance The school level also can provide a student group view of selected filtered student response data <u>Can contain confidential student information</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Useful to district to present overall view of district student performance Useful to district data staff to view district level data down to school level data
Dynamic Student Report (AK STAR only)	For use by district users and school administrators	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provides individual student’s summative scale score and achievement level Provides growth component overall RIT scores, growth, percentiles, and instructional area RIT scores Provides the following information for test items: item type, level of difficulty, standard alignment, response time, and tools used <u>Contains confidential student information</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Useful to district and administrative staff to view overall student performance Allows for a quick view of student summative and MAP Growth performance
