


# AMP Summative Assessment Achievement Levels

Students' scores on the AMP summative assessment fall into one of four achievement levels. The score ranges for each achievement level vary by grade and content area (English language arts and math). The lowest and highest possible scores for all grades are 620 and 780. The lowest score for meeting the standards is 700 at all grades. Students whose scores fall in levels 3 and 4 are meeting the standards; students whose scores are in level 1 and 2 are partially meeting the standards.
