Mt. Edgecumbe High School is Accepting Applications

SITKA -- Mt. Edgecumbe High School, the state-operated boarding school in Sitka, is accepting applications for enrollment for next school year. The school typically enrolls approximately 400 students from over 100 villages and other communities. About 84% of Mt. Edgecumbe's students are Alaska Native.

Mt. Edgecumbe continues to operate as a four-year high school serving a variety of students. Students have an opportunity to take courses in the arts, sciences, social studies, English, world languages, mathematics, computer science, physical education, ETT/EMT, welding, and construction. Graduating with an engineering or health science specialty are options.

Nearly all students who stay for four years graduate with a diploma. Ninety-three percent of 2014 graduates were accepted into post-secondary university or technical training programs, with 7% enlisting in the military or joining the workforce.

Mt. Edgecumbe offers extracurricular activities in sports, drama, debate, forensics, leadership, and scores of recreational activities.
