State Board Seeks Public Comment on Proposed Regulations Implementing Alaska's ESSA Plan

JUNEAU -- The State Board of Education and Early Development, meeting April 25 by audio conference, sent out for public comment proposed regulations implementing Alaska's Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) plan. Public comment may be submitted on DEED's website.

The proposed regulations are required to implement accountability and school support and improvement systems for schools and districts in Alaska, as specified in ESSA and Alaska's state plan. ESSA was signed into federal law on December 10, 2015, replacing the No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB).
