State Board to Meet January 29 in Juneau

JUNEAU -- The State Board of Education and Early Development will meet on January 29 in the first-floor board room at 801 West 10th Street in Juneau. The meeting will begin at 11:00 a.m. The board's meeting packet is available at https://education.alaska.gov/state_board/pdf/1_29_BoardPacket.pdf.

The purpose of the meeting is to hold a work session and a business meeting. Topics at the work session include a review of the department's FY2019 operating and capital budgets, a legislative update, a proposed regulation change regarding the Uniform Chart of Accounts and Account Code Descriptions for school districts, an update on board bylaw changes, a guest presentation on professional development, and a board self-evaluation training.

Topics at the business meeting include the proposed regulation change noted above and approval of the department's FY2019 operating and capital budgets, the minutes from the December 7-8, 2017 meeting, and the board's annual report to the legislature.

The board will take public comment on agenda and non-agenda items starting at approximately 11:10 a.m. Oral comment is limited to three minutes per person and five minutes per group. Public comment can be made for the meeting, during this time only, by calling 1-844-586-9085 if you are outside of Juneau or Anchorage. For participation from Juneau, call 586-9085. For participation from Anchorage, call 563-9085.

The meeting will be live-streamed through the Legislative Information Office (LIO) over http://www.akl.tv/ beginning at 11:00 a.m. (audio only). Click on the meeting name to listen to the proceedings. When public comment is over, the meeting will continue to be broadcast at the above website.
