The purpose of the quarterly meeting is to hold a work session and a business meeting. Topics at the work session include a legislative and budget update, a review of Mt. Edgecumbe High School graduation requirements, an update on the UAA School of Education accreditation process, board committee reports, and the adoption of regulations regarding school facility planning and construction and school facility commissioning.

Topics at the business meeting include adoption of the regulations listed above, standing reports on the department's divisions, the commissioner's report, appointment of the Special Assistant to the Commissioner, approval of the June 7, July 24, and August 21 meeting minutes, and an executive session to discuss the FY2021 department budget.

While in Anchorage, the board will also be participating in the department's 2019 Alaska School Safety and Well-Being Summit at the Egan Center.
