## State Board to Meet December 4 by Audio Conference

The purpose of the quarterly meeting is to hold a work session and a business meeting. Topics at the work session include the draft annual board report to the Legislature, Mt. Edgecumbe High School graduation requirements, board committee reports, and regulations to go out for public comment regarding the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) accountability and assessment regulations as well as emergency certificates. The board will also hear a guest presentation from Senator Bert Stedman regarding the Mt. Edgecumbe Aquatic Center.

Topics at the business meeting include the Mt. Edgecumbe High School graduation requirements, the regulations listed above, standing reports on the department's divisions, the commissioner's report, approval of the September 19, 2019 and October 23, 2019 meeting minutes, the draft annual board report to the Legislature, and an executive session to discuss the selection of the board's student advisor.
