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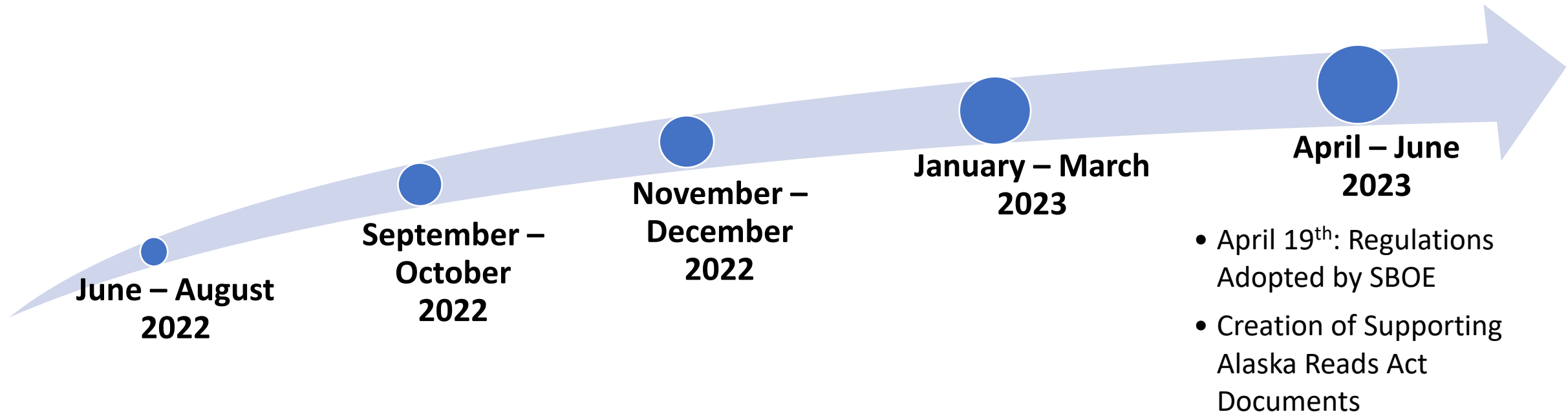

- Support/coach districts/ schools with adjustments to the MTSS plan



MTSS Plan

- Support districts in creating/ refining MTSS plans (Tier 1, Tier 2, Tier 3)
- Coach districts/ schools/ educators to problem solve elements within MTSS plans

Individual Reading Improvement Plans

- Support schools/ educators to create effective IRIPs
- Coach schools/ educators through parent communication protocol
- Support/ coach schools/ educators with IRIP parent meeting
- Provide **tutoring** services to districts/ schools for far below students
- Support schools/ educators with targeted interventions (programs such as mCLASS interventions, mCLASS Boost, UFLI and Heggerty)

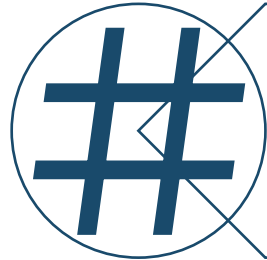
