

The Readiness for Accreditation Self-Assessment Checklist

The EPP completes the checklist below to assess its readiness to provide evidence¹ in each of the key areas required to meet CAEP Revised Standards. The *Readiness for Accreditation Self-Assessment Checklist* supports the EPP in deciding when they will be ready to host a CAEP site review.

Please consult the CAEP Revised Standards and the CAEP Workbook in conducting the self-assessment using the tables below. As you complete the self-assessment checklist, please bear in mind the following information on phasing in CAEP requirements under the 2022 Revised Standards.

Please use the following definitions for the purposes of this checklist.

- **Undeveloped:** At the time of completion of the checklist, no data have been collected and no plan is in place to collect data for the relevant component of the Standard.
- **In Development:** A defined plan is in place for collecting three cycles² of data to show evidence for the relevant component of the Standard. At least one cycle of data that can be used to show partial evidence for the component has already been collected by the provider.
- **Developed:** The provider has a system in place and has collected three cycles of data to show sufficiency for the relevant component of the Standard.

¹ Evidence is documentation, multiple and valid measures, and analysis provided as the basis for and proof of an educator preparation provider's (EPP) ability to meet sufficiency criteria for a component of a CAEP Standard.

² Cycles are culminated in points during which the EPP has administered assessments, surveys, or other measures. The reported cycles of data should be sequential and be the most recent available. The frequency are defined by the EPP and may depend on the data set – once per year, once per cohort, once per semester, etc.
