

# **eDIRECT FAQs**

## **What is eDIRECT?**

eDIRECT is a DRC web site that provides you quick and easy access to Online Enrollment, Student Precode, Reports and other useful documents/tools (i.e. DRC Memos, Data File Layouts, GTIs, PowerPoints, ect.).

## **What is Enrollment?**

Enrollment is the process that allows districts to enter school enrollment counts for regular test books and accommodated materials.

## **What is Precode?**

The Student Precode System allows districts to transfer a student data file via eDIRECT's secure website. DRC will pull information from the eDIRECT Precode System in order to generate student precode labels for districts to apply to the students' test booklets. Precoding reduces administrative time and increases accuracy by eliminating the need to "bubble" individual student data by hand at the time of testing.

## **What is in the Student Data File?**

The Student Data files (Abbreviated and Long text files) contain student level data with demographic and assessment detail. These are posted under eDIRECT's "Report" application for both the fall and spring assessments.

## **What is in the District School Roster?**

The District School Roster contains standard level scale score data by grade for each subject and school alphabetically within a district.

## **What is in the District Subpopulation Summary Report?**

The District Subpopulation Summary Report provides details for the percent and number of students in each proficiency level by school and demographic reporting category.

## **What is the Student Report (ISR)?**

The Student Report is the Individual Student Report (ISR) which provides a record of the student's test results including scale score, proficiency level by subject, and performance by standard.

## **What is in the School Student Roster?**

The School Student Roster includes scale score information by overall test and standards for each student within a school listed alphabetically by student.

## **What is the School Summary Report?**

The School Summary Report provides an analysis of group standards mastery using the average scale score obtained for each reportable standard and details the percent of students in each proficiency level. This report also provides a proficiency level summary comparison by State, District, and School.

## **What is the School Subpopulation Summary Report?**

The School Subpopulation Summary Report provides details for the percent and number of students in each proficiency level by demographic reporting category.
