<b>AMP Computer-Based Assessment (CBA)</b> <b>ELA, Math, Science</b>	Gr 3-10	Measures students' mastery of the Alaska ELA, Math and Science Standards. Science tested in grades 4,8,10 only. See the detailed Alaska Measures of Progress (AMP) Assessment Calendar – Spring 2016.
<b>AMP Paper-Based Assessment</b> <b>ELA, Math, Science</b>	Gr 3-10	Measures students' mastery of the Alaska ELA, Math and Science Standards. The paper-based assessment is available to school with a waiver from computer-based assessment and to students who need a paper-based accommodation. Paper-based accommodation assessments may be administered during the main AMP window. Paper-based school assessments have a limited window (March 29-April 8). Science tested in grades 4,8,10 only.
<b>ACCESS 2.0 for ELLs</b>	Gr K-12	Measures the English language proficiency of students who are identified as English language learners (ELLs) or Limited English Proficiency (LEP) students.
<b>DLM Alternate Assessment - ELA &amp; Math</b> <b>Science Alternate Assessment</b>	Gr 3-10	Students with significant cognitive disabilities who are not able to complete regular or substitute courses will take these assessments.
<b>College and Career Readiness Assessments</b>	Grade 11	Measures students' readiness for college entry or career. Required for grade 11 students; available to grade 12 students who have not previously taken the assessment. Districts are required to administer one or both college-readiness assessments (ACT, SAT) and the career-readiness assessment (WorkKeys). Students choose either a college readiness assessment or a career-readiness assessment. Students taking college-readiness assessments may choose to include writing. Students taking the career-readiness assessment must take all three subtests: Applied Mathematics, Reading for Information, and Locating Information.
<b>Developmental Profile</b>	Gr K or 1	This assessment indicates: the student's physical health; social and emotional development; approaches to learning; cognition and general knowledge; communication, language, and literacy; and the student's background.

**Content Assessments ELA & Math Grades 3-10** **March 29 – April 29; extended window closes May 6**

- Each content area has 4 sections (25+15+15+15).
- Sections may be given over the course of several days. A section must be completed within one day.
- ELA & Math sections may be administered on unique schedules at the school, grade, or individual level.
- Window closures per grade level are for *scheduled* testing. If necessary, make-up testing can occur for any grade during any day within the window (March 29-April 29).

**Science Grades 4, 8, 10** **March 29 – April 29; extended window closes May 6**

- 3 sections/Grade 4 (25+12+12) grades 8 & 10 (25+15+15)
- Sections may be given over the course of several days. A section must be completed within one day.
- Science sections may be administered on unique schedules at the school, grade, or individual level.

Best practice is to limit student testing time to one hour sessions and total time per day of approximately two hours.
