## Protocol for Reporting Assessment Results

## Four Categories of Achievement

No results will be reported if less than five students total are tested.
If only one achievement level has a value, that value is suppressed and the percentage of students at that level will be reported as a range. All other values are suppressed.

If only two achievement levels have values reported, and the number of students in one of those achievement levels is one or two, the number of students will be eliminated in all achievement levels and the percentage of students at each achievement level will be reported as a range. Ranges will be reported according to the table below.

If 3 of the 4 achievement levels have values then all values will be reported.

| Number of Students Tested | Achievement Level Range |
| :--- | :--- |
| 5 | $60 \%$ or more proficient (or not proficient) <br> $40 \%$ or fewer not proficient (or proficient) |
| 8 | $75 \%$ or more proficient (or not proficient) <br> $25 \%$ or fewer not proficient (or proficient) |
| 10 | $80 \%$ r more proficient (or not proficient) <br> $20 \%$ r fewer not proficient (or proficient) |
| 20 | $90 \%$ or more proficient (or not proficient) <br> $10 \%$ or fewer not proficient (or proficient) |
| 40 (or more) | $95 \%$ or more proficient (or not proficient) <br> $5 \%$ or fewer not proficient (or proficient) |
